

### **2018 TYRE** REGULATIONS

### **Allocation per race**



#### 10 front slicks:

- ✓ Up to 5 A-specification tyres
- ✓ Up to 5 B-specification tyres
- ✓ Up to 5 C-specification tyres

#### 12 rear slicks:

- ✓ Up to 6 A-specification tyres\*
- ✓ Up to 5 B-specification tyres
- ✓ Up to 4 C-specification tyres

(\*) Riders who participate in both Q1 and Q2 qualifying sessions (maximum 2 riders) will be allocated one extra front tyre of their preferred specification after Q2 (therefore, if taken, a maximum of 6 of that specification) and one extra rear slick tyre of specification A (highest grip level) after Q2 (therefore, if taken, a maximum of 7 of specification A).

In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are both declared wet by the Race Director, the extra tyres allocated will be a rain tyres (of the specification the rider prefer for both front tyre and rear tyre). In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are declared as different weather conditions (dry or wet) then no extra tyre will be allocated.



### 5 front tyres:

- ✓ Up to 3 A-specification tyres
- ✓ Up to 3 B-specification tyres
  - > 3As + 2Bs, or 2As + 3Bs

### 6 rear tyres:

- ✓ Up to 4 A-specification tyres
- ✓ Up to 3 B-specification tyres
  - > 4As + 2Bs, or 3As + 3Bs

Should four of the following five sessions (Free Practice 1, 2, 3 and 4, and one Qualifying session) be declared wet, an additional set of rain tyres is allocated to all the riders. This additional allocation comprises:

> ✓ 6 front rain tyres (3 A-spec + 3 B-spec rain tyres) √ 7 rear rain tyres (4 A-spec + 3 B-spec rain tyres)

Michelin Motorsport Two-Wheel Manager:

This is a circuit we all know very well as we come here every year for a pre-season test and it is an ideal track to understand about the bikes and the tyres. The track surface was re-laid in 2016, so it should be properly settled now, and although we have lots of data for here it does also still require a lot of thought as it is one of the hottest venues we visit and the track temperatures can be quite extreme, it is

not unusual to see it go over 50°C. The tyres are pushed to the extremes to cope with the high temperatures and have shown their full potential since we returned to MotoGP, they have also had to show their wet weather prowess, as we have had quite a few damp sessions at Malaysia since our return. This will be the final race of a five-week tour that has seen us take in Thailand, Japan and Australia so far, these are all very important venues for Michelin and MotoGP and it has been great to see the support and passion that there is in these places for the sport and we are sure it will be no different this weekend in Sepang.
