

2020 TYRE REGULATIONS

ALLOCATION PER RACE:

MICHELIN POWER "SLICK":

10 Power front slicks

- ✓ Up to 5 Power Slick Soft
- ✓ Up to 5 Power Slick Medium
- ✓ Up to 5 Power Slick Hard







12 Power rear slicks

- ✓ Up to 6 Power Slick Soft
- ✓ Up to 5 Power Slick Medium
- ✓ Up to 4 Power Slick Hard







Riders who participate in both Q1 and Q2:

- ✓ + 1 MICHELIN Front Power Slick (of the specification the riders prefer)
- ✓ 1 MICHELIN Rear Power Slick Soft

In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are both declared wet by the Race Director, the extra tyres allocated will be rain tyres. In the case that Q1 and Q2 sessions are declared as different weather conditions (dry or wet) then no extra tyre will be allocated.

MICHELIN POWER RAIN:

In the case that any 4 of the 5 sessions, being FP1, 2, 3, 4, and one Qualifying session (excluding warm-up), are declared wet, one more set of rain tyres will be allocated to every rider, and the allocation automatically becomes: 7 Front rain tyres, and 8 Rear rain tyres.



AS THERE ARE LOTS OF SLOWER

CORNERS AND HARD BRAKING

Le Mans is usually one of our busiest races as a company as we have many people from Clermont-Ferrand

and the other Michelin factories visit us during the weekend, but that will not happen this year due to the protocols, but we will still have a very busy time with three races in two days. Le Mans is a circuit that needs special attention as there are lots of slower corners and hard braking, so the front tyre has a lot of work to do, so we choose the compounds carefully to suit that, plus this season we will be going at a completely different time to usual, it could be very cold in the morning,

but with the compounds we have selected for the weekend we have taken that into consideration.

MotoE will come to a close during the weekend, with two races and the winner decided. It has been a really positive season for us, we have had some great racing so far and the new tyres we introduced for this year have performed really well. The information we gather from them will help translate what we take from the track to the street, as we look at more environmentally friendly options as Michelin moves forward.




Thanks to ongoing innovation work, the FIM MotoE[™] World Cup:


- Uses new Enel X battery chargers.

RACE FORMATS

PRACTICE

Two practice sessions (30 minutes) on Friday

E-POLE QUALIFYING PRACTICE

Each rider will carry out 3 laps of the circuit (one warm up lap - one timed lap - one slow down lap).

The riders will start one by one, from the end of the pit lane

The starting order of the riders will be the opposite of the combined free practice results

GRID

Grid positions will be based on the fastest time recorded by the riders in the E-Pole qualifying session.

In the case where the E-Pole qualifying session has been cancelled, the grid position will be based on the fastest times recorded by riders in all free practice sessions.

RACE

Riders will complete one sighting lap before taking their position on the grid. There is no warm up lap, once the grid preparations have finished, the red light will go out and the race starts.

Tyre warmers may be used on the grid.

Charging of the battery on the grid is permitted
